FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is the cost?

- \$140 per child (early bird is \$130, ends 1st September 2019)
- \$100 for junior leaders (Year 8 and above) and adult leaders
- If cost is an issue, please speak to us. We would still love your child to attend and will arrange support to help with their costs.

2. How do I register for camp?

- Hand in your registration form at the registration desk on Sundays or via the friend who gave you the form, or register online at wesleyinternational.org.au
- You can pay by cash, credit card or direct deposit. You will receive a phone call before we process your credit card.
- Please register soon to guarantee a seat on the coach that will transport you back from campsite to Ryde.

3. What time is arrival and departure?

- Arrival time is 4pm, Saturday 28th September. Please note you cannot drop off your child early.
- Camp finishes at 2pm, Monday 30th September. If your child is catching the coach, the coach will arrive at Princes Street, beside Ryde Park around 5pm.
- Note there is no end-of-camp church service involving the parents as camp finishes on a weekday.

4. How do I get my child to Crosslands Youth & Convention Centre?

- Camp starts on Saturday at 4pm, which enables you to drop off your child at Crosslands Reserve. We will email you specific instructions for drop off closer to the date.
- You may wish to arrange carpooling with other families.

5. How will my child get home from Crosslands Youth & Convention Centre?

- You can either pick up your child at 2pm from Crosslands Centre, OR
- Your child can go on the coach (\$9/person) and will get dropped off at Princes Street, beside Ryde Park around 5pm (coach seats are on a first come, first served basis).

6. How many campers will there be?

- We expect 50 campers, but we can accommodate up to 100.
- We also expect around 30 adult and junior leaders.

7. What if my child has special dietary requirements?

- Please specify on the registration form (eg: egg free, gluten free, vegetarian).

8. What does my child need to bring to camp?

- We will email you the details closer to the date, so please provide your email address clearly on the registration form.

9. What if I need to reach my child in an emergency?
