## **Refreshed Relationship**

Times of refreshing come from our relationship with God and His presence (Acts 3:20). He daily renews our inner being (2 Cor 4:16) into the image of our Creator (Col 3:10). He regenerates us by the power of the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:5). This year we want to encounter more of God's refreshing.



## **Refreshed Community**

The Spirit birthed a **new** community that refreshed each other daily (Acts 2:42-47). Whether through prayer, teaching, sharing meals, encouragement or care, the early church refreshed one another. This year we want to grow in being a refreshing church community for one another.



## **Refreshed World**

Jesus said that to those who believe in Him, out of their hearts would flow rivers of living water (Jn 7:37-39). God has always intended that His refreshing not only satisfy our thirst, but flow through us to touch our world. This year we want to be a loving source of God's refreshing to our world.

# **Growing Church & Unity Partnerships**


We cannot transform our cities alone. Ongoing and new robust partnerships with other churches and ministries are vital to transform lives and transform our cities.




## **Next Step Sundays**

## 1. Salvation




Attendees at WIC services, groups and programs will be encouraged to make a decision to put their faith, trust and hope in Jesus and His finished work on the cross for them throughout the year and on "Next Step" Sundays.

#### **Growth Tool 1: Christian Basics Program**



#### **Initial Decisions**




Those considering making the decision or who have recently made the decision to follow Jesus are encouraged to take the next step to participate in the:

#### **Christian Basics Program**

When a pre/new believer takes this step, they agree to meet with an equipped believer for for six 1.5 hour sessions to eplore the basics of the Christian faith.

#### **Growth Tool 2 – "First Steps" Program**



Once a new believer has completed the Basic Discipleship program, they will then have the option to grow in their faith by completing the 7-week *First Steps* program with an equipped believer. Topics covered in this program include:

- Experiencing God's Love and Forgiveness
- Living with the Assurance of Salvation
- Living in the Power of the Holy Spirit.

## 2. Baptism



Those who have accepted Jesus as Lord will be encouraged to take the next step of Baptism. In 2024, there will be two official baptism Sundays on the following dates:


- 7 April
- 10 November

Baptisms may also occur on other Sundays, as required.


#### **Growth Tool 3 – Baptism Classes**

All baptism candidates are offered two one-hour preparation sessions in the weeks prior to the baptisms. The sessions cover the following material:

- Meaning of salvation through faith in Christ
- Biblical meaning of Baptism
- Biblical imperative of Baptism
- Common questions regarding Baptism
- Church Membership

#### 3. Growing Together

The Scriptures are full of examples of believers meeting together in smaller groups to encourage one another and to grow in their faith. A key step in discipleship growth is to join a smaller discipleship group in the church.

Individuals may consider joining an existing life group or start a new one to focus on one or more aspects of spiritual growth, including Bible study, prayer, fellowship, outreach etc.



## 4. Serving

Our faith in Jesus naturally leads us to love and serve others. Therefore, a next step in your discipleship journey could be to join a serving team within WIC and/or the broader Christian community.




## **Growth Tool 4 – SHAPE**

God has shaped each one of us uniquely, each one having our own combination of talents, passions, experiences and spiritual gifts to be able to serve in His kingdom.

Those wishing to take the next step of joining a serving team can make use of the SHAPE tool which includes videos, exploratory studies and questions to help determine the best kingdom serving opportunity for them.

## 5. Bible Sharing

All believers in Jesus are encouraged to share their faith with those they encounter in their world. The next step for a growing Christian is to help others discover and grow in their knowledge of Jesus by reading the Bible with a friend or acquaintance who is a pre-believer.





#### **Growth Tool 5 – DBM**

Those wishing to take the next step of reading the Bible with a pre-believer will have access to training in the **Discovery Bible Method (DBM)** which involves reading a small passage of the Bible with the pre-believer and asking simple questions concerning the text. This has helped countless people to encounter Jesus through the Scriptures and come to a personal faith in Him.



## Growth Tool 6 – "*My Friends*" Training

This training provides biblical principles and a practical and natural approach to reaching out to those who don't yet know Jesus.



## 6. Mission

All disciples of Jesus are called to be involved in Mission, taking the good news about Jesus to those who don't yet know Him.

A next step for you as a disciple of Jesus may be to get involved in local and/or global mission. There are many ways to be involved in mission, including going, sending, praying and supporting missionaries and mission partners.
